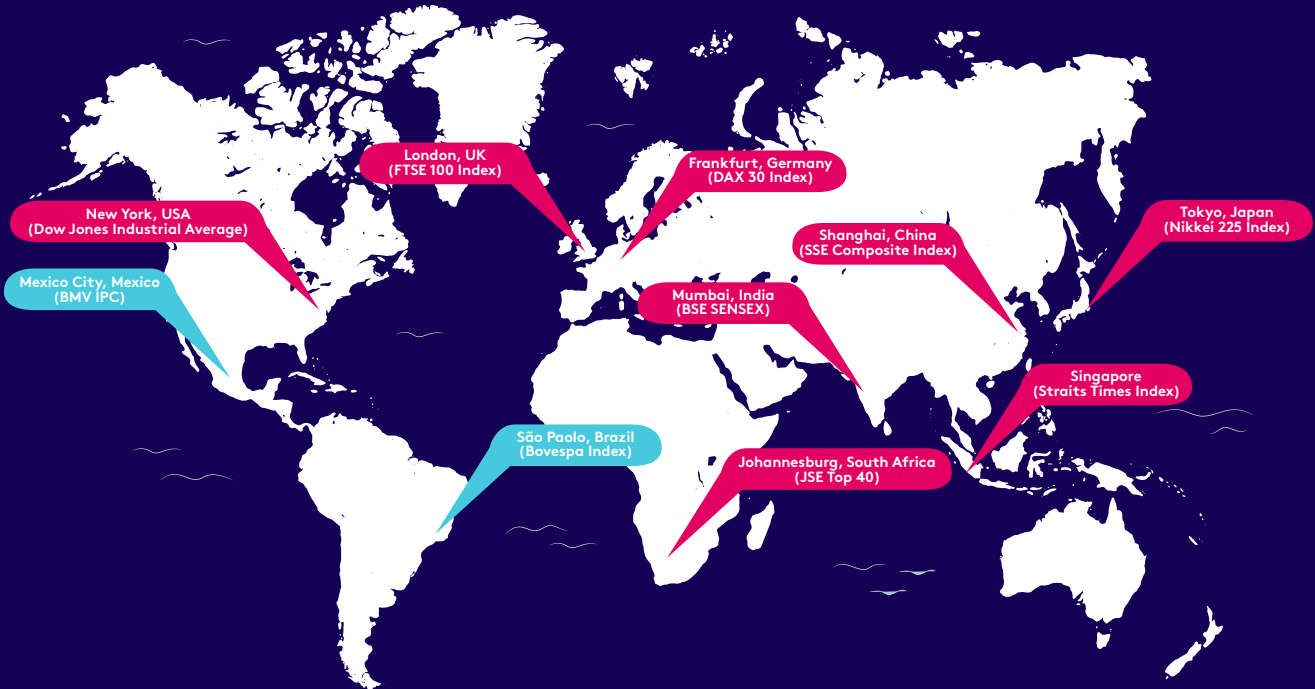

The US' NASDAQ Composite showed volatility on Friday, at one point **dropping more than 4%** before lunchtime.

Among the European countries most hit economically by the current pandemic is the UK, whose FTSE 100 index is **down over 20%** in the last year.

In Eastern Asia, South Korea's Kospi Composite appears to be doing alright, with a monthly **growth of around 3.87%**.

In the US alone, **1.4 million jobs were reported** as new for the month of August, a sign that growth could be back on track. However, this number is very little, in comparison with the number of jobs lost since the month of March when the coronavirus began to take hold of the country. In fact, in the month of July, the number of Americans who officially filed for unemployment reached **51 million**. Across the **globe**, more than **one billion are without jobs**, and income inequality appears to be on the rise.

The Trump Administration in the United States has taken many efforts to [reduce and block immigration](#) to the North American giant over the last four years. This attempt to block immigrants from countries like El Salvador, Sudan, Haiti, and Nicaragua (all of whom have [historically been given temporary protected status](#)).



Peru to Participate In COVID Vaccine Testing

The South American country of [Peru](#) has signed an agreement with the pharmaceutical company AstraZeneca to participate in vaccine testing. In fact, the Andean country will [receive 300 million doses](#) as part of the deal. This news comes after months of [small group testing](#), which showed promising results. AstraZeneca has been [collaborating with Oxford University](#) to develop and fund the process of vaccine creation.



Brazil to Pay Soccer Players Fairly



Around the world, professional soccer players have been [paid unfairly](#) based on gender for as long as the sport has been around. Women playing to represent their countries, despite even having better track records, have significantly been underpaid. Now [Brazil](#), a major soccer country, has announced that it plans to pay its [women and men's teams national teams](#) the same. This announcement marks a [global first](#), and could lead the way for European and other American teams to follow suit.

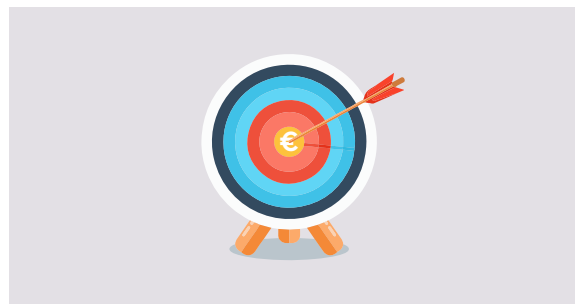
